Proceedings of the meeting held on 12.2.2019, under the chairmanship of CEO, to discuss the strategies for maximization of Youth Voters enrolment.

At the outset CEO welcomed all the officers and briefed them about the enrolment of youth voters (age group of 18-19 years) in the State of Karnataka. In the State of Karnataka, as per the census 23.49 lakh is the estimated youth voters population in the age group of 18-19 years but, now the actual enrolled voters population is 7.14 lakh. It was also observed that in some of the districts like BBMP (South), Central Gulbarga, Kodagu, Yadgir, Hassan, Raichur, etc., less than 25% of the target population are enrolled. Hence, concerted effort is required to be made in the next few weeks to maximize the end youth enrollment. In this background present meeting is being held to request the Higher Education Department, Technical Education Department, Youth Services and Empowerment Department, Labour Department, etc., to assist election related offices - District Election Officer - Deputy Commissioners, Electoral Registration Officers - EROs, BLOs in identifying the young enrolled youth population and also to facilitate their enrollment. A preliminary meeting regarding this was held last week, under the chairmanship of Additional CEO with Commissioner, Collegiate Education, Commissioner,

Youth Services & Sports, Commissioner, Labour Department, Commissioner, Skill Development and Commissioner, School Education were asked to prepare an Action Plan for youth enrollment.

2. The Commissioner, Collegiate Education informed the Chair that there are about 64,500 students studying in medical, para-medical and dental colleges. Efforts are being made to contact these students through their educational institutions and to motivate them for enrollment. In the technical education department, it was mentioned that about 17,000 young enrolled youth have been identified for enrollment and out of which 12000 Form 6 have been provided to them.

3. It was requested to take up some special drive in all educational institutions, including private institutions, to enroll the young voters. The Viswesvariah Technical University may also be approached. The Principal Secretary, Higher Education, was requested to issue necessary instructions to all the departments, District Level officers to contact college Principals and Campus Ambassadors in their jurisdiction to disburse and facilitate collection of Form 6, in co-ordination with the Deputy Commissioners, Tehsildars and the Electoral Registration Officers. It was mentioned that instructions have already been issued to all the Deputy Commissioners to work in co-ordination with District Level Officers of Higher Education, Labour, Youth Services, School Education, Zilla Panchayat, Woman and Child Department, etc., for the enrollment of young voters. Commissioner, Collegiate Education, mentioned that in many of the colleges the department has organized certain special camps in co-ordination with the jurisdictional BLOs. In such camps, the BLOs have refused to collect forms pertaining to other BLOs.

4. It was stated that instructions are being issued to all the Deputy Commissioners to ensure that whenever such special camps are conducted, the AERO, Tehsildars of the Taluk have to attend and all the forms being

collected in the college campuses have to be collected with due acknowledgement to the applicant.

5. The youth services Joint Director ?? mentioned that every district has certain number of youth clubs and instructions will be issued to Assistant Directors of the district and the NSS officers to co-ordinate with these youth clubs for enrollment of un-enrolled youth voters.

6. Labour?? from the Labour Welfare Board and the Labour Department was instructed to identify areas which has high concentration of working labourers, industrial layouts, etc., and draw a plan of action to enroll the left out electors.

7. It was also mentioned that camps can be conducted in all colleges with wide publicity and SVEEP consultant will organize SVEEP materials through the Collegiate Education Department in such camps.

8. The Principal Secretary, Higher Education and the Commissioner, Collegiate Education were once again requested to take all necessary steps to maximize youth enrollment through their departmental efforts. It was informed that another meeting may again be held after 10 days to review the progress achieved.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks.
